- **All women leadership team!**




Our Impact

- 231,200+ pounds (920,000+ individual servings) donated to those in need since inception (this year already 34,000 pounds donated).
- Powered by volunteers (“Farm Angels”) who have donated 125,000+ hours (5,000 hours this year) in planting and harvesting.
- Farming education from preschool to seniors including a Ft. Campbell partnership training retiring veterans in agriculture.
- We donate to over a dozen Second Harvest Food Bank partner agencies across Middle Tennessee.
- Nearly one million Tennesseans struggle with food insecurity, with 690,000 families relying on SNAP benefits each month. By Faith Farm is bridging the gap by donating fresh, chemical- and pesticide-free produce to nourish, heal, and bring hope to those who need it most.







The new cool room offers over 53 square feet of climate controlled space to keep freshly harvested produce at optimal temperatures.

Overall Community Impact of Grant Funds



- **Purposeful Cultivation** – With the Impact 100 Nashville Grant, we will expand food distribution to 300,000 pounds, equating to 1.2 million servings (since the farms inception) — a **30% increase** in reach.
 - According to Mayo Medical, one pound of fresh fruits and vegetables equals four servings.
- **Engaging Community Volunteers** – We also plan to increase volunteer participation by 20% annually, thereby expanding our capacity and promoting long-term sustainability.
- **Distributing Food Through Partners** – Maintain and strengthen partnerships with 10+ community organizations to distribute 300,000 pounds of fresh produce to vulnerable populations.
